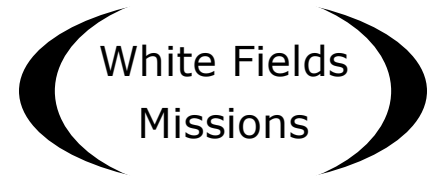


# Adriana's House

### **Trip Details**

- \$200 participation fee—includes 6 nights lodging, food from Sunday evening 10/4 to Saturday morning 10/10, home building administrative fee. **Payable to White Fields by Sunday, 9/13/09.**
- \$80 transportation fee—approximate cost for shared travel costs to/from your home town and Mexico OR approximate cost for rental vehicle, fuel, and insurance to/from San Diego and Mexico. Round trip to San Diego

is at participants own expense if that option is chosen. There are many variables with this item based upon your point of origination and the group you may be travelling with so contact us with specific questions about this item.

- \$50 extra cash—approximate amount of extra cash that should be taken for in transit meals and miscellaneous spending.
